



MATCHING GIFT PROGRAM

Donor Eligibility:

- Active CME, NYMEX and COMEX members and lessees who have held memberships for at least one year prior to the date of their gift. The maximum amount matched is \$1,000 per donor per calendar year, not per membership. Clearing Firm employees are not eligible for the Matching Gift Program.
- Full-time active CME Group, CMA and DJI employees who have completed at least one year of service prior to the date of their gift.
- Members of the Board of Directors of CME Group Inc. who have completed at least one year of service prior to the date of their gift.

Guidelines for Participation:

- Gifts of cash or securities with a quoted market value will be matched on a dollar-for-dollar basis. The value of a gift of securities with a quoted market value is determined by the closing market price on the date of the gift.
- Matching gifts will be made at least four times each year. We anticipate gifts will be made in March, June, October and December.
- Each gift must be a minimum of \$25 and submitted on a separate form.
- The maximum amount matched is \$1,000 per person per calendar year and may consist of any combination of gifts under the program guidelines.
- Matching gift forms must be received by the CME Group Community Foundation by December 15 of the calendar year in order to qualify for the program that year. Forms received after December 15 will qualify for the program in the following year.
- The CME Group Community Foundation must receive a completed matching gift form from the recipient organization within 90 days of a donor's gift.

- Matching gifts will be made by check and paid directly to the receiving organization without reference to a specific project or division.
- Confirmation of matching gifts will be forwarded to donors by the CME Group Community Foundation after the gift is made.
- The CME Group Community Foundation may, if it determines that it is necessary or appropriate to do so, suspend, revise or terminate this program at any time, or limit the aggregate amount of its contributions for CME, NYMEX and COMEX members and CME Group, CMA and DJI employees in any calendar year.
- If, in accordance with Program guidelines, there is a question concerning donor or organization eligibility to participate in the Matching Gift Program, the final decision regarding such eligibility will be made by the CME Group Community Foundation.

Organization Qualifications:

Organizations receiving matching gifts from the CME Group Community Foundation must be recognized as tax-exempt, nonprofit organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. If applicable, proper accreditation is also required.

Eligible organizations include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Nonprofit private and public degree-granting graduate and professional schools, universities, four-year and two-year colleges in the United States and Canada
- Public and private elementary and secondary schools in the United States
- Human service agencies providing direct services to children, families, the homeless, victims of domestic abuse, the elderly and people with disabilities
- Cultural institutions, performance and visual arts organizations, museums, zoos, libraries, etc. that are open to the general public

Ineligible Organizations:

- Any organization that discriminates by race, color, religion, age, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, ancestry, disability, marital status, veteran status or other protected status
- Athletic teams, booster clubs or support organizations
- Private foundations
- Fraternities, sororities and alumni groups
- Religious and political organizations
- Nursing homes, rest homes, convalescent organizations, long-term care facilities and medical research organizations
- Fraternal or veteran organizations
- Ministries, theological or bible schools
- Professional associations
- School choirs, bands or drill teams
- Scouting organizations

Ineligible Gifts:

- Non-cash gifts (other than securities with a quoted market value), real or personal property or personal services (e.g. works of art, clothing or donated labor)
- Bequests and memorials
- Campaign donations (including United Way)
- Pledges, tithes or tuition payments
- Subscriptions, membership dues, insurance premiums or student fees
- Tickets for cultural or sporting events and benefit dinners
- Raffle or admission payments
- Money collected from a group of people or money paid by sponsors to participants in walkathons, telethons and similar fundraising activities
- Gifts that are made as a consequence of, or lead to, material, direct benefit to the donor, a member of the donor's family or an individual designated by the donor; or are used to satisfy a legal obligation
- Membership or subscription portion of a donation (for example, you donate \$100 to a museum; however, in return you receive a family membership valued at \$60. The matchable portion of your donation is \$40)
