**SUBJECT: Position Limits, Accountability Levels and Large Trader Reporting Requirements in Connection with the Initial Listing of the Australian Wheat FOB (Platts) Futures Contract**

In connection with the listing of the Board of Trade of the City of Chicago, Inc.'s ("CBOT" or "Exchange") Australian Wheat FOB (Platts) futures contract on trade date Monday, July 24, 2017 (see [SER-7941](#) dated June 28, 2017), please note below and in [Appendix B](#) of CBOT Submission No. [17-238](#), the corresponding spot month position limit (Rule 559), aggregation allocations (Rule 559.D.), single month and all month accountability levels (Rule 560) and reportable levels (Rule 561) for the new contract. The contract shall have diminishing balances. The spot month limit effective date shall be the first trading day of the expiring contract month.
