

## Chapter 611

# 1% Fuel Oil Rdam (Platts) vs. 1% Fuel Oil NWE (Platts) Futures

#### 611.01. SCOPE

The provisions of these Rules shall apply to all contracts listed on the Exchange for cash settlement based on the Floating Price.

## 611.02. FLOATING PRICE

The Floating Price for each contract month is equal to the arithmetic average of the high and low quotations from Platts European Marketscan for 1% Fuel Oil under the heading "Barges FOB Rotterdam" minus "Cargoes FOB NWE" assessment for each business day that both are determined during the contract month (using Non-common pricing).

## 611.03. CONTRACT QUANTITY AND VALUE

The contract quantity shall be 1,000 metric tons. Each contract shall be valued as the contract quantity (1,000) multiplied by the settlement price.

#### 611.04. CONTRACT MONTHS

Trading shall be conducted in contracts in such months as shall be determined by the Exchange.

### 611.05. PRICES AND FLUCTUATIONS

Prices shall be quoted in U.S. dollars and cents per metric ton. The minimum price fluctuation shall be \$0.001 per metric ton. There shall be no maximum price fluctuation.

## 611.06. TERMINATION OF TRADING

Trading shall cease on the last business day of the contract month.

## 611.07. FINAL SETTLEMENT

Delivery under the contract shall be by cash settlement. Final settlement, following termination of trading for a contract month, will be based on the Floating Price. The final settlement price will be the Floating Price calculated for each contract month.

### 611.08. EXCHANGE OF FUTURES FOR RELATED POSITION TRANSACTIONS

Any Exchange of Futures for Related Position (EFRP) transactions shall be governed by the provisions of Exchange Rule 538.
