- 1 Revisions to Rule 442 (“Notification of Significant Events”) and Rule 853 (“Transfer of Transfer of Trades and Customer Accounts”)

**I. REVISIONS TO RULE 442 (“NOTIFICATION OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS”) AND
RULE 853 (“TRANSFER OF TRANSFER OF TRADES AND CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS”)**

Pending all relevant regulatory review periods, CME, CBOT and NYMEX will adopt revisions to Rule 442 (“Notification of Significant Events”) and Rule 853 (“Transfers of Trades and Customer Accounts” formerly titled “Transfers of Trades”), on January 4, 2012. These revisions are being made in accordance with the Commodity Futures Trading Commission’s (“CFTC”) new regulations for derivatives clearing organizations (“DCOs”). CFTC Regulation 39.16(d), which becomes effective on January 9, 2012, requires each DCO to have a rule that requires clearing members to provide prompt notice to the DCO if the clearing member becomes the subject of a bankruptcy petition, receivership proceeding, or the equivalent. CFTC Regulation 39.15(d), which also becomes effective on January 9, 2012, requires each DCO to have rules providing that it will promptly transfer all or a portion of a customer’s account from one clearing member to another, provided that the conditions in the Regulation are satisfied.

The revisions to Rules 442 and 853 are set forth below, with additions underscored and deletions overstruck:

Chapter 4 – Enforcement of Rules

Rule 442. NOTIFICATION OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Each Member shall provide immediately ~~ly~~ notice to ~~fy~~ the Market Regulation Department (and each Member that is a Member Firm or a Clearing Member shall also provide immediate notice to the Clearing House), in writing upon becoming aware of any of the following events relating to such Member:

1. any suspension, expulsion, revocation or restriction of such Member’s trading privileges or any fine in excess of \$25,000, through an adverse determination, voluntary settlement or otherwise, by any court, commodity or securities exchange or related clearing organization, the Securities and Exchange Commission, the Commodity Futures Trading Commission or the securities commission or equivalent authority of any state, territory, the District of Columbia or foreign country, the National Futures Association, the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority, Inc. or any self-regulatory or regulatory organization;
2. any indictment of the Member ~~-~~ or any of its officers for, any conviction of the Member ~~-~~ or any of its officers of, or any confession of guilt or plea of guilty or nolo contendere by the Member or any of its officers to 1) any felony or 2) any misdemeanor involving, arising from, or related to the purchase or sale of any commodity, security, futures contract, option or other financial instrument or involving or arising from fraud or moral turpitude; and/or 3. any filing of a involuntary bankruptcy petition or insolvency, receivership or equivalent proceeding of which the Member is a subject. that has been filed against such Member, or i in the case of a voluntary bankruptcy, insolvency, receivership or equivalent proceeding, the Member also shall notify the Market Regulation Department, ~~-(and the Clearing House in the case of a Member that is a Member Firm or Clearing Member) when when~~ such Member ~~- has filed — or — has —~~ formed a definite intention to file such ~~proceeding for —~~ proceeding ~~bankruptcy.~~ Nothing in this Rule shall limit or negate any other reporting obligations that any member may have to the Exchange or any other regulator or person.

Chapter 8 – Clearing House and Performance Bonds

Rule 853. TRANSFERS OF TRADES AND CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS

853.A. Transfers of Trades

1. Subject to the limitations of Rule 854, existing trades may be transferred either on the books of a clearing member or from one clearing member to another clearing member provided:

i1. The transfer merely constitutes a change from one account to another account provided the underlying beneficial ownership in said accounts remains the same; or

ii2. An error has been made in the clearing of a trade and the error is discovered and the transfer is completed within two business days after the trade date.

B2. Subject to the limitations of Rule 854, Exchange staff may, upon request by the clearing member(s), approve a transfer of existing trades either on the books of the same clearing member, or from the books of one clearing member to the books of another clearing member if the transfer is in connection with, or as a result of, a merger, asset purchase, consolidation or similar non-recurring transaction between two or more entities where one or more entities become the successor in interest to one or more other entities.

3C. Exchange staff may, with the consent of the clearing member(s) involved, permit the transfer of existing trades if, in staff's opinion, the situation so requires and such transfer is in the best interests of the Exchange.

4D. Provided that the transfer is permitted pursuant to Sections 1A., 2B. or 3C. above, transactions in all physically delivered futures contracts except for FX futures contracts must be recorded and carried on the books of the receiving firm at the original trade dates; all other transactions may be recorded and carried at either the original trade date or the transfer date. Futures transactions may be transferred using either the original trade price or the most recent settlement price; options transactions may be transferred using either the original trade price or a trade price of zero.

E5. All transfers shall be reported to the Clearing House in a form acceptable to the Exchange for the type of transactions involved. The proper indicator must be included in the transfer such that the transactions, including the transaction(s) to reverse an error, clear as transfers. The clearing members involved shall maintain a full and complete record of all transactions together with all pertinent memoranda.

853.B. Transfers of Customer Accounts

1. Subject to the limitations of Rule 853.A, after receipt of a signed instruction from a Clearing Member (the "Carrying Clearing Member") to transfer all or a portion of a customer account to another Clearing Member (the "Receiving Clearing Member"), and provided that such instruction contains the customer's name and account number (and, if the transfer is not of the entire account, a description of which portion is to be transferred), and provided that the Receiving Clearing Member agrees to accept the account, the Exchange shall promptly transfer the account (or the relevant portion thereof), without requiring any close-out or rebooking of positions in connection with the transfer, provided that:

i. The transferred positions will satisfy Exchange performance bond requirements at the Receiving Clearing Member;

and

ii. Any remaining positions in the customer account at the Carrying Clearing Member will satisfy Exchange performance bond requirements.

Commodity Futures Trading Commission Regulation 1.35 (“Records of cash commodity, futures, and options transactions”) and CME, CBOT, NYMEX and COMEX Rule 536.D. (“Customer Type Indicator (CTI) Codes”) require that an accurate customer type indicator code (“CTI Code”) must be submitted for every transaction executed electronically or by open outcry. This Advisory Notice is being issued to remind clearing members of the requirement for the accurate submission of CTI Codes.

Rule 536.D. indicates that it is the responsibility of clearing member firms to ensure that each electronic and open outcry transaction submitted to the Exchanges includes the correct CTI Code. Clearing firms should take steps to ensure that they have processes and procedures in place that result in the accurate submission of CTI Codes. Clearing firms are reminded that failure to transmit accurate CTI Codes in accordance with Rule 536.D. may result in disciplinary action.

NON-MEMBER: AMARILLO BROKERAGE COMPANY

CME RULE VIOLATION: 534. WASH TRADES PROHIBITED

No person shall place or accept buy and sell orders in the same product and expiration month, and, for a put or call option, the same strike price, where the person knows or reasonably should know that the purpose of the orders is to avoid taking a bona fide market position exposed to market risk (transactions commonly known or referred to as wash sales). Buy and sell orders for different accounts with common beneficial ownership that are entered with the intent to negate market risk or price competition shall also be deemed to violate the prohibition on wash trades. Additionally, no person shall knowingly execute or accommodate the execution of such orders by direct or indirect means.

432.Q. GENERAL OFFENSES

It shall be an offense to commit an act which is detrimental to the interest or welfare of the Exchange or to engage in any conduct which tends to impair the dignity or good name of the Exchange.

FINDINGS: Pursuant to an offer of settlement in which Amarillo Brokerage Company (“Amarillo”) neither admitted nor denied any rule violations upon which the penalty is based, on December 20, 2011, a panel of the CME Business Conduct Committee found that on numerous dates between December 2008 and June 2010, two employees of Amarillo executed 541 transactions totaling 3,750 contracts in the expiring Live Cattle futures contracts where there was common beneficial ownership on both sides of the transactions. The opposing buy and sell orders were placed with the knowledge and intent that the orders would match opposite one another, and Amarillo’s purpose in doing so was to freshen long futures position dates prior to the commencement of the respective delivery months. The Panel found that, in committing these actions, Amarillo violated CME Rules 534 and 432.Q.

The Panel recognized that Amarillo executed these transactions opposite one another based on a misunderstanding of Exchange rules, and that, although no violations of CME Rule 533 (Simultaneous Buy and Sell Orders for Different Beneficial Owners) were alleged, in all but 6 transactions, Amarillo exposed its initial order to the marketplace for at least 5 seconds prior to entering an order on the opposite side of the market.

PENALTY: In accordance with the offer of settlement, the Panel fined Amarillo Brokerage Company \$75,000.

EFFECTIVE DATE: December 30, 2011

Reference to CME Rule 534 (Wash Trades Prohibited) includes legacy versions of the same substantive rule that were in effect at the time of the alleged violations.

Amarillo is a guaranteed introducing broker of a CME clearing member. Accordingly, Amarillo falls within the definition of “member” for purposes of Chapter 4 of the CME rule book.

CME RULE VIOLATIONS: Rule 432 – GENERAL OFFENSES

It shall be an offense to:

- Q. commit an act which is detrimental to the interest or welfare of the Exchange or to engage in any conduct which tends to impair the dignity or good name of the Exchange.
- T. to engage in dishonorable or uncommercial conduct.

FINDINGS: Pursuant to an offer of settlement in which Charles Martell (“Martell”), a non-member proprietary trader working for a member firm and subject to the jurisdiction of the Chicago Mercantile Exchange (“CME”) pursuant to CME Rule 400, neither admitted nor denied the findings and conclusions herein, on January 18, 2012, a Panel of the CME Business Conduct Committee (the “Panel”) found that from October 1, 2009 through October 31, 2009, Martell traded index futures, including E-mini NASDAQ 100 Index futures contracts (“Mini -Nasdaq”) over the CME Globex (“Globex”) electronic trading platform. During this period, the Panel found that Martell entered into a trading strategy that misled other market participants, including algorithmic trading strategies employed by other firms, and exploited that deception for Martell’s benefit.

The Panel specifically found that during the subject timeframe, Martell entered into Globex over 3,000 “large” orders consisting of 500 to 1,000 Mini-Nasdaq contracts without the intent to trade those orders. When doing so Martell typically began the trading day flat in his account and thereafter established a long (short) position by rapidly entering a number of aggressive one-lot orders. Once Martell established his long (short) position he then layered the sell (buy) side of the book at various price levels that, if traded, would have completely liquidated his previously established position at a profit. The Panel found that immediately after completing the entry of his liquidating orders, Martell then entered numerous “large” buy (sell) orders consisting of 500 – 1,000 contracts on the same side of the market as his already established long (short) position to induce other market participants to trade.

In determining Martell’s intent to not trade the “large” orders, the Panel took into consideration the exposure time and cancellation rate of Martell’s “large” orders and how close in time his cancelations were to the fills he received on his liquidating orders relative to Martell’s average order size, exposure times and cancellation rates.

The Panel found that in so doing, Martell violated CME Rule 432.T. (to engage in dishonorable or uncommercial conduct) and 432.Q. (to engage in an act which is detrimental to the interest or welfare of the Exchange or to engage in any conduct which tends to impair the dignity or good name of the Exchange).

PENALTY: Taking into account all the relevant factors, including Martell’s financial condition, the Panel ordered Martell to pay a fine of \$80,000 and serve an 18 month bar from 1) applying for, owning, or holding a membership of any exchange owned or controlled by CME Group Inc.; 2) access to all CME Group Inc. trading floors; and 3) direct and indirect access to all electronic trading and clearing platforms owned or controlled by CME Group, including CME Globex. The suspension shall run from January 20, 2012 through and including July 19, 2013.

CME RULE VIOLATION: 539. **PREARRANGED, PRE-NEGOTIATED AND NON-COMPETITIVE TRADES PROHIBITED**

- A. No person shall prearrange or pre-negotiate any purchase or sale or non-competitively execute any transaction. . . .

FINDINGS: After a full evidentiary hearing on the merits on October 27, 2011, a Panel of the Chicago Mercantile Exchange (“CME”) Business Conduct Committee (“BCC Panel”) found that on December 31, 2008, Daimyon Rivera prearranged the execution of two orders in the Eurodollar futures pit. The Panel found that in so doing, Daimyon Rivera violated CME Rule 539.A.

PENALTY: In accordance with its findings, the Panel ordered Rivera to pay a fine in the amount of \$2,000; barred Rivera from applying for membership in any CME Group Inc. exchange for a period of five business days; and barred Rivera’s direct and indirect access to all CME Group electronic trading and clearing platforms for a period of five business days.

CME RULE VIOLATIONS: Rule 432. General Offenses (in part)

It shall be a violation:

B. to engage in fraud, bad faith, or in conduct or proceedings inconsistent with just and equitable principles of trade;

C. to engage in dishonest conduct.

Rule 539. General Prohibition

A. No person shall prearrange or pre-negotiate any purchase or sale or noncompetitively execute any transaction.

FINDINGS: Pursuant to an offer of settlement in which non-member Gary Wilks ("Wilks") neither admitted nor denied the rule violation upon which the penalty is based, a Panel of the CME Business Conduct Committee ("BCC") found that from February 1, 2008 through October 31, 2008, while controlling accounts for his employer, Daisy Brand LLC, Wilks executed a series of noncompetitive trades for his personal account opposite his employer's account in a manner designed to allow Wilks to profit at Daisy Brand's expense. Wilks either used Daisy Brand's account to establish or offset a trade at a price that allowed him to profit, or executed round-turn trades with Daisy Brand's accounts resulting in a movement of money to Wilks' personal account. The BCC found that in so doing, Wilks violated CME Rule 432.B., Rule 432.C., and Rule 539.A.

PENALTY: In accordance with the settlement offer and in consideration of the fact that Wilks recompensed Daisy Brand nearly \$80,000 on his own accord, the BCC permanently barred Wilks from: applying for membership at any CME Group exchange; directly or indirectly accessing, using, or entering orders on any electronic trading or clearing platform owned or operated by CME Group; accessing any trading floor owned or operated by any CME Group exchange; and affiliating with or being employed by any Member, as defined by CME Rule 400.

CBOT RULE VIOLATION: Rule 432. (General Offenses) (in part)

It shall be an offense:

T. to engage in uncommercial conduct

FINDINGS: Pursuant to an offer of settlement in which Scott Brady ("Brady") neither admitted nor denied the rule violation upon which the penalty is based, on January 27, 2012, a Panel of the CBOT Business Conduct Committee found that on September 16, 2009, while employed as a trader for a member firm of the Exchange, Brady executed trades in the user defined December 2009 10-Year U.S. Treasury Note 119 Call – 115 Put risk reversal covered against futures at a price of 117.00½ on the CME Globex electronic trading platform wherein he entered individual 1-lot orders against the covered risk reversal so as to receive an over-allocation of short futures at a price of 117.00½, when the prevailing futures market was approximately 116.26 ½ bid, offered at 116.27. Brady subsequently agreed to transfer the over-allocated futures back to the counter-party. The Panel found that in entering the 1-lot orders in such a manner, Brady violated CBOT Rule 432.T. (To Engage in Uncommercial Conduct).

PENALTY: In accordance with the settlement offer and in consideration of evidence that there were no discernable profits realized by Brady in executing these trades as the Exchange reversed the over-allocated futures, the Panel fined Brady \$20,000.

**CBOT RULE
VIOLATIONS:** **(legacy) Rule 534. WASH TRADES PROHIBITED**

No person shall place for the same beneficial owner buy and sell orders for the same product and expiration month, and, for a put or call option, the same strike price, at or about the same time with the intent to avoid a bona fide market position exposed to market risk (transactions commonly known or referred to as wash sales). Buy and sell orders placed for the same beneficial owner in the same product and expiration month, and for a put or call option, the same strike price, must be entered in good faith for the purpose of executing bona fide transactions that result in a change of ownership. Additionally, no person shall accept, execute or accommodate the execution of orders which are prohibited by this rule with knowledge of their character.

Rule 432.W. GENERAL OFFENSES

It shall be an offense for a Member to fail to diligently supervise its employees and agents in the conduct of their business relating to the Exchange.

FINDINGS: Pursuant to an offer of settlement in which Glencore Grain BV (“Glencore”) neither admitted nor denied any rule violations upon which the penalty is based, on January 27, 2012, a panel of the Chicago Board of Trade (“CBOT”) Business Conduct Committee found that on one or more occasions between January 2009 and July 2009, two employees of Glencore executed 7 transactions totaling 495 contracts in non-spot month Soybean Oil, Soybean Meal, and Wheat futures contracts where there was common beneficial ownership on both sides of the transactions. The opposing buy and sell orders were placed with the knowledge and intent that the orders would match opposite one another, and Glencore’s purpose in doing so was to transfer positions from one account to another. The panel found that in doing so, Glencore violated CBOT Rules 534 and 432.W.

PENALTY: In accordance with the offer of settlement, the Panel fined Glencore \$35,000.

(a) No person shall purchase any futures contract, purchase any call option or sell any put option for his own account, or for any account in which he has an interest or for an account over which he has discretionary trading authority, while in possession of any executable order of another person for the purchase of any futures contract, the purchase of any call option or the sale of any put option in the same product.

(b) No person shall sell any futures contract, sell any call option or purchase any put option for his own account, or for any account in which he has an interest, or for an account over which he has discretionary trading authority, while in possession of any executable order of another person for the sale of any futures contract, the sale of any call option or the purchase of any put option in the same product.

Rule 529. WITHHOLDING ORDERS PROHIBITED

A Member (as defined in Rule 400), or any person entering orders on the Globex platform, shall not withhold or withdraw from the market any order, or any part of an order, for the benefit of any person other than the person placing the order.

Rule 539. PREARRANGED, PRE-NEGOTIATED AND NONCOMPETITIVE TRADES PROHIBITED (in part)

A. No person shall prearrange or pre-negotiate any purchase or sale or noncompetitively execute any transaction, except in accordance with Sections B. (Block Trades) and C. (Globex Trades in Interest Rate, Ethanol & Dow Options).

FINDINGS: Pursuant to an offer of settlement in which Joel Himel ("Himel") neither admitted nor denied the findings and conclusions herein, on December 13, 2011 a Panel of the CBOT Business Conduct Committee (the "Panel") made the following findings:

On twelve occasions from April 16, 2007 through October 31, 2007, Himel executed Soybean futures trades over the e-cbot electronic trading platform for his personal account while in possession of executable customer orders. In so doing, Himel violated legacy CBOT Regulations 350.05(a) and 350.05(b) (Trading Practices).

Further, the Panel found that on eight occasions between October and December 2008 Himel entered into noncompetitive, prearranged trades in Soybean futures contracts while in possession of executable customer orders that he withheld from the marketplace for the benefit of other traders. In so doing, Himel violated CBOT Rule 539.A. (Prearranged, Pre-negotiated and Noncompetitive Trades Prohibited), and Rule 529. (Withholding Orders Prohibited).

PENALTY: In accordance with the settlement offer, the Panel ordered Himel to (i) pay a fine of \$20,000; (ii) serve a 40 business day suspension of his 1) membership privileges; 2) access to any CME Group Inc. trading floors; and 3) direct access to all electronic trading and clearing platforms owned or controlled by CME Group, including CME Globex; and (iii) never again handle customer orders in a floor broker capacity at any CME Group Inc. exchange. The suspension shall run from January 3, 2012, through and including February 29, 2012.

FINDINGS: Pursuant to an offer of settlement in which David Lohman ("Lohman") neither admitted nor denied the rule violation upon which the penalty is based, on January 27, 2012, a Panel of the CBOT Business Conduct Committee found that on September 16, 2009, while employed as a trader for a member firm of the Exchange, Lohman executed trades in the user defined December 2009 10-Year U.S. Treasury Note 119 Call – 115 Put risk reversal covered against futures at a price of 117.00½ on the CME Globex electronic trading platform wherein he entered individual 1-lot orders against the covered risk reversal so as to receive an over-allocation of short futures at a price of 117.00½, when the prevailing futures market was approximately 116.26 ½ bid, offered at 116.27. Lohman subsequently agreed to transfer the over-allocated futures back to the counter-party. The Panel found that in entering the 1-lot orders in such a manner, Lohman violated CBOT Rule 432.T. (To Engage in Uncommercial Conduct).

PENALTY: In accordance with the settlement offer and in consideration of evidence that there were no discernible profits realized by Lohman in executing these trades as the Exchange reversed the over-allocated futures, the Panel fined Lohman \$20,000.

FINDINGS: Pursuant to an offer of settlement in which Newedge USA, LLC ("Newedge") neither admitted nor denied the rule violation upon which the penalty is based, on December 20, 2011, a Panel of the CBOT Business Conduct Committee ("Panel") found that on January 11, 2011, Newedge, a clearing member, submitted an in-house transfer to the Clearing House ("CME Clearing") with inaccurate trade data for an expiring contract. This reporting error originated from a give-in Newedge received with inaccurate information which then required manual handling. While attempting to correct this give-in transaction that was erroneously designated as a customer account origin, Newedge incorrectly submitted the in-house transfer to CME Clearing as January 2011 Soybean futures rather than the January 2012 contract due to a clerical typographical error. As a result, the open interest in January 2011 Soybean futures was overstated by 3,750 contracts. Due to this reporting error's inclusion in the Daily Bulletin and on the Exchange website, CME Group was required to publish a correction, remove the open interest and rerun the Final Daily Bulletin. In so doing, Newedge failed to submit accurate trade data to CME Clearing in violation of CBOT Rule 809.A.

PENALTY: In accordance with the settlement offer, the Panel fined Newedge \$25,000.

Q. to commit an act which is detrimental to the interest or welfare of the Exchange or to engage in any conduct which tends to impair the dignity or good name of the Exchange.

FINDINGS: Pursuant to an offer of settlement in which Martin Rogers (“Rogers”) neither admitted nor denied the findings and conclusions herein, on November 17, 2011, a Panel of the CBOT Business Conduct Committee (the “Panel”) made the following findings: That during the period of January through March 2009, Rogers, a member of the CBOT, and a floor trader in the CBOT Dow Jones Industrial Average Index (\$10 Multiple) (“Dow”) futures pit, knowingly recorded fictitious futures trades on his personal trading cards and submitted the trading cards to his clearing member firm on nine (9) occasions. The trading cards he submitted to his clearing firm appeared to be bona-fide trades that occurred in the Dow pit, but were not legitimately executed opposite another trader. Six (6) of these trades were reported to the Exchange for clearing, but resulted in out-trades and never cleared. As a result of submitting these trading cards, Rogers’ actual futures position was not apparent to his clearing firm on all nine (9) occasions and margin calls between \$1,599 and \$76,000 were avoided on five (5) occasions, thus placing Rogers’ clearing firm at risk.

The Panel found that in so doing, Rogers violated CBOT Rule 432.D. (to create or report a false or fictitious trade) and Rule 432.Q. (to commit an act which is detrimental to the interest or welfare of the Exchange or to engage in any conduct which tends to impair the dignity or good name of the Exchange).

PENALTY: In accordance with the settlement offer, the Panel fined Rogers \$30,000 and ordered him to serve a 50 business day suspension of his 1) membership privileges; 2) access to all CME Group Inc. trading floors, and 3) direct access to all electronic trading and clearing platforms owned or controlled by CME Group Inc. The suspension will run from December 16, 2011, through and including February 29, 2012.

Zagorin neither admitted nor denied the rule violations upon which the penalty is based, on December 20, 2011, a Panel of the CBOT Business Conduct Committee found that on February 26, 2010, Zagorin failed to adhere to the spot month speculative position limit for Corn futures by entering an order to purchase 750 March – May 2010 Corn futures. At this time, Zagorin had already established a long March Corn futures position of 123 contracts. Zagorin's order was filled in its entirety in 20 milliseconds, causing his March 2010 Corn futures position to peak at 873 contracts long, exceeding the spot month speculative position limit of 600 contracts by 273 contracts. The Panel found that in so doing, Zagorin violated legacy CBOT Rule 443. (Position Limit Violations).

PENALTY: In accordance with the settlement offer and in consideration of Zagorin's history of position limit violations, the Panel fined Zagorin \$60,000 and suspended his membership privileges, access to any CME Group trading floors, and direct access to any CME Group electronic trading or clearing platform for 15 business days, beginning on December 27, 2011, and continuing through and including January 17, 2012.

PENALTY: In accordance with the settlement offer, the Panel ordered Eckhardt to pay a fine to the Exchange in the amount of \$25,000.

PENALTY: In accordance with the settlement offer, the Panel ordered Mathews Capital to pay a fine to the Exchange in the amount of \$60,000.
