REMINDER – CHANGES TO WHEAT VOMITOXIN SPECIFICATIONS BEGINNING WITH THE SEPTEMBER 2009 CONTRACT

Effective with the September 2009 and subsequent deliveries, Shipping Certificates delivered in satisfaction of Wheat futures contracts shall be marked as either 3 parts per million or fewer vomitoxin or 4 parts per million or fewer vomitoxin. Shipping Certificates marked as 3 parts per million or fewer vomitoxin will be delivered at contract price, while Shipping Certificates marked as 4 parts per million or fewer vomitoxin will be delivered at a 12 cent per bushel discount. Shipping Certificates issued by Regular Facilities prior to the September 2009 delivery period will be marked as 4 parts per million or fewer vomitoxin.

Holders of Wheat Shipping Certificates issued prior to the September 2009 delivery period may, at a mutually acceptable price, request that the issuing warehouseman upgrade the Shipping Certificate to a 3 parts per million or fewer vomitoxin Certificate.
