1. Complete MAS Info form. Return form to FTS Helpdesk, CBOT, via fax 312-341-3408
2. Provide and support end to end LAN/WAN connectivity between firm and CBOT.
3. Provide and support at least one router (switch not supported) located in the CBOT interstitial area with at least one 10 meg, half duplex Ethernet handoff to CBOT. The handoff must be copper. The router must use CBOT provided IP addresses and support NAT.
4. Provide security for the network
5. For wireless only, verify that application can run with 64k bandwidth limit.
6. Review and complete the MAS Rules and Acknowledgement form. Return to FTS Help Desk, CBOT, via fax 312-341-3408.

**CBOT Role**

1. Provide an Ethernet UTP handoff to member firm in the CBOT Interstitial area.
2. For wireless only, provide IP addressing, WEP keys, and SSID.
