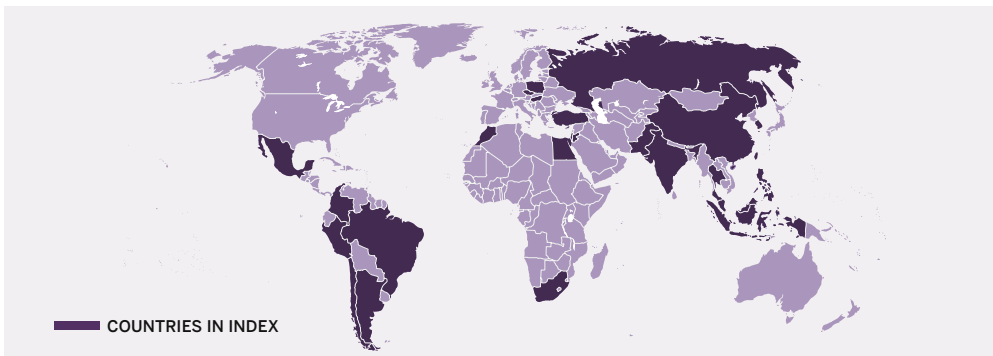

The MSCI Emerging Markets Index is a free float-adjusted market capitalization index designed to measure equity market performance in 25 global emerging markets. It is comprised of more than 800 of the largest, most liquid companies available in those countries.
