



Decline in the Black Sea Grain Production-2022











Ukrainian Public Farms: Stock Prices Drop




Ukrainian wheat at the global market




Ukrainian corn at the global market




Ukrainian sunflower oil at the global market




Drastic drop in grain export after February 24th




Domestic Ukrainian Values dropped

Vegoils Prices and Ukraine SFS Prices, USD/MT









Main crops sowing areas in Ukraine, 2021


















Military Risk: Gap between Planted and harvested areas, 2022




Ukraine. The biggest decline in Sunseed Harvest, 2022

















Ukrainian Corn: Main Export Destinations













Ukraine. Agricultural export by transport mode. 20/21






Marine traffic in Black sea and Azov sea







Ukraine. Transshipment of agricultural products for export through seaports, MY 2020/21

Baltic Sea Ports able for Ukraine export grain transshipment






