SUBJECT: **Change in Self-Quarantine Requirement for Fully Vaccinated Individuals Following Domestic Travel**

To align with changing health agency and local government guidance, individuals in our trading floor community who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 will no longer need to self-quarantine following domestic travel within the United States. Individuals are considered fully vaccinated two weeks after their final dose of any vaccine.

The travel section of the self-assessment tool has been updated to allow you to certify that you have been fully vaccinated if you have traveled domestically. If you answer affirmatively, you will receive an "Entry Pass" screen.

If you have not been fully vaccinated, you will still need to self-quarantine for 10 days following all domestic travel. Alternately, non-vaccinated individuals who obtain a negative COVID-19 test administered three to five days after returning home may have their self-quarantine time reduced to seven days, presuming they report their negative COVID-19 test to the Healthcare Center.

Please note that all individuals in the trading floor community who travel internationally, whether they have been fully vaccinated or not, will need to self-quarantine according to the timelines above, reporting their negative COVID-19 test to the Healthcare Center if applicable.

Other trading floor health and safety protocols, including wearing masks and social distancing, remain in place for everyone, regardless of vaccination status.
