Transferee Relationship

Private agreements between the transferor and transferee shall not be recognized by the Exchange and shall not affect the rights of the Exchange or its members.

PURSUANT TO THE RULE 106.C:

As Transferor, I hereby transfer ownership of my membership Interest to the Related Transferee to be effective upon Transferee's approval to membership.

Private agreements between the transferor and transferee shall not be recognized by the Exchange and shall not affect the rights of the Exchange or its members.

- 1. The transferee shall have no authority to sell, transfer or assign the membership interest;
- 2. All assignments for clearing purposes made by the transferor shall continue until canceled by the transferor;
- 3. The transferor retains the right to sell or transfer the membership at any time;
- 4. Upon the death or formally declared incompetence of the transferor, the transfer shall be revoked and membership shall revert to the transferor's estate or conservator.
