
Visit the Museum of American Finance

The Museum of American Finance, an affiliate of the Smithsonian Institution, is the nation's only public museum dedicated to money, finance and entrepreneurship.

It occupies the former home of the Bank of New York, founded by Alexander Hamilton in 1784, and offers five permanent interactive exhibits. Items on display include ticker tape from the Crash of 1929, the earliest photograph of Wall Street, paper money, coins, gold bars, and documents and artifacts tracing the development of the financial markets.
