### Large Trader Reporting Under CFTC Part 17

On April 30, 2024, the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC”) approved final rules to amend its [Large Trading Reporting Regulations for Futures and Options](#). The amendments were made to modernize CFTC’s Large Trader Reporting process and align it with other reporting structures outlined in CFTC regulations. These final rules became effective upon publication in the Federal Register on June 3, 2024. Reporting Firms must comply with the CFTC’s final rules regarding Large Trader Reporting Requirements two years after publication in the Federal Register.

Firms required to report their positions in accordance with Large Trader Reporting requirements may receive files containing Unique Instrument Codes from CME, CBOT, NYMEX, and COMEX (each an “Exchange” and together the “Exchanges”). The Exchanges will provide these files to firms as described in the [CME Group Client Systems Wiki](#).

Further guidance regarding Large Trader Reporting will be disseminated in subsequent Special Executive Reports as solutions become available.
