SUBJECT: Vomitoxin Levels on Wheat Futures and Slightly-Weathered Condition on Oat Futures to be reported on the Daily Issues and Stops Facility Detail Report

Effective immediately, The Board of Trade of the City of Chicago, Inc., (“CBOT” or “Exchange”) will begin publishing additional information on its Daily Issues and Stops Facility Detail Report (the “Report”).

Commencing with the March 2016 contract month and beyond, the Exchange will publish the vomitoxin level indicated on delivered Wheat Futures (Rulebook Chapter 14; Clearing Code: W; CME Globex Code: ZW) shipping certificates in the “GRADE” column of the Report. Also at this time, the “GRADE” column of the Report will indicate if slightly weathered oats shipping certificates are specified on delivered Oat Futures (Rulebook Chapter 15; Clearing Code: O; CME Globex Code: ZO).
