SUBJECT: Delisting of Previously-Listed Contract Months and Amending the Listing Schedule for the LLS (Argus) vs. Brent Crude Oil Average Price Option Contract

Earlier today, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (NYMEX or Exchange) delisted the previously listed contract months for the LLS (Argus) vs. Brent Crude Oil Average Price Option contract as noted in the table below. There is no open interest in the delisted contract months.

In addition, effective Sunday, October 18, 2015 for trade date Monday, October 19, 2015, and pending all relevant CFTC regulatory review periods, the Exchange will amend the listing schedule for this contract also proposed in the table below.
