**SUBJECT: Delisting of the California Carbon Allowance (CCA) Futures and Option Contracts**

Earlier today, Monday, November 9, 2015, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (“NYMEX” or “Exchange”) delisted two (2) California Carbon Allowance (CCA) products as set out in the table below. The subject futures contract was listed for trading on CME Globex and for submission for clearing via CME ClearPort; the subject option contract was listed for trading on CME Globex and the NYMEX trading floor as well as for submission for clearing via CME ClearPort. There was no open interest in the contracts.

The contract rule chapters and terms and conditions were deleted from the Exchange rulebook. Additionally, the terms and conditions of the contracts being delisted were deleted from the Exchange’s website and the Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 of the NYMEX Rulebook was also removed from the Exchange rulebook. All other references to the contracts have been deleted from the NYMEX Rulebook and all trading specifications have been removed from the Exchange’s website.
