CME Term SOFR Reference Rates are administered by CME Group Benchmark Administration Limited (“CBA”), which is a regulated benchmark administrator under the UK Benchmark Regulation¹.

CBA is duly authorised and supervised by the UK Financial Conduct Authority (FCA) and adheres to the IOSCO Principles for Financial Benchmarks.

On April 7th 2026, CBA was granted recognition as a third-country benchmark administrator pursuant to Article 32 of the EU Benchmarks Regulation² (“EU BMR”) with respect to CBA’s ‘significant’ EU benchmark, the CME Term SOFR Reference Rates. This recognition permits the continued use of these rates by supervised entities within the European Union.
