# Benchmark Oversight Committee Framework

As of 13 November 2025, CBA has implemented a new tiered oversight committee framework (together the “Oversight Function”), covering the index families administered by CBA.

The purpose of the Oversight Function is to review the accuracy, representativeness, reliability and integrity of benchmarks administered by CBA by providing independent oversight and challenge to the Administrator.

The Oversight Function consists of two types of oversight committees, a BMR Joint Oversight Committee (“JOC”) and Product Advisory Committees (“PACs”).

## BMR Joint Oversight Committee

The BMR Joint Oversight Committee is responsible for the overall direction and coordination of the Oversight Function and for the interaction with the management body of CBA. The JOC is supported by and is an escalation point for the Product Advisory Committees (see details below).

Details of the responsibility of the JOC can be found in the Terms of Reference published on the relevant benchmark website pages.

## Product Advisory Committees

Product Advisory Committees preside over major methodology developments and changes relating to specific index families as well as cessation and/or consultation decisions. The PACs provide technical oversight of the operation of the benchmarks as well as the underlying market and how changes could impact the continued representativeness and integrity of the benchmarks. The PACs provide their views and recommendations to both the JOC and CBA Management.
