**Re: NEX SEF Limited – Tenth Amended Application for Registration as a Swap Execution Facility**

Dear Secretary:

EBS Global Facility Limited (“EGFL”) previously submitted a Form SEF and accompanying exhibits on April 29, 2016 (the “Application”) for registration as a swap execution facility (“SEF”) pursuant to Section 5h of the Commodity Exchange Act and Part 37 of the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“Commission”) Regulations. On July 29, 2016, August 11, 2016, November 4, 2016, November 23, 2016, and January 5, 2017, EGFL submitted Form SEFs and accompanying exhibits amending the Application. On December 30, 2016, ICAP plc (“ICAP”), the then-parent company of EGFL, sold its global voice broking business. As part of this transaction, ICAP became a wholly owned subsidiary of NEX Group plc (“NEX Group”) and rebranded its business operations as NEX Group. Accordingly, on January 30, 2017, EGFL changed its name to NEX SEF Limited (“NEX SEF”). On January 31, 2017, February 17, 2017, March 23, 2017, and June 7, 2017, NEX SEF submitted Form SEFs and accompanying exhibits amending the Application.

NEX SEF hereby submits an eleventh Form SEF and accompanying clean and marked revised exhibits amending the Application.

NEX SEF is separately filing, pursuant to Commission Regulations 37.3(b)(2) and 145.9, a petition for confidential treatment of those portions of its amended application that are not required by Commission Regulation 40.8(a) to be made publicly available.
