1. Introduction & Overview

The objective of the Self-Match Prevention (SMP) enhancements pre-launch mock is to ensure that customers have an opportunity to test enhanced SMP functionality in the CME Globex production environment.

Market participants will have the opportunity to test the following:

- **Accurate Registration of SMP IDs:** Customers will be able to submit orders into Globex to verify SMP IDs for new or existing SMP IDs are properly registered in the Firm Administrator Dashboard (FADB).
- **SMP functionality enforcement:** Customers will be able to verify proper handling of Session Level Rejects (tag 35-MsgType=8) related to orders submitted with unregistered SMP ID/Globex Firm ID combinations.

Please Note: SMP IDs must be properly registered via the FADB no later than 4:30 p.m. Central Time (CT) on **Thursday, September 28** to ensure readiness for the mock trading session.

The CME Global Command Center (GCC) will be staffed to support this session. There will be a conference bridge line open during the testing. Customers are encouraged to dial into this line for real-time updates during the customer mock session.
