SUBJECT: Delisting of Certain Natural Gas Futures and Option Contracts and

**Amendment to Aggregation Allocations of Existing Related Contracts** 

As announced in Special Executive Report <u>SER-8000</u>, earlier today, the New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") delisted one-hundred and forty-eight (148) natural gas futures and option contracts (the "Delisted Contracts"). As a result of this delisting, the Exchange amended the aggregation allocations of certain existing related contracts (the "Amended Contracts") to reflect the new aggregation allocations. The Delisted Contracts and Amended Contracts are set forth in <u>Appendix C</u> and <u>Appendix D</u>, respectively, of NYMEX Submission No. <u>17-378</u>.

The terms and conditions of the Amended Contracts have been updated in the <a href="NYMEX Position Limit">NYMEX Position Limit</a>, <a href="Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table">Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table</a> located in the Interpretations & Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 of the NYMEX Rulebook. The Delisted Contracts have been removed from the NYMEX Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table.
