SUBJECT: Position Limits, Accountability Levels and Large Trader Reporting Requirements in Connection with the Initial Listing of Physically-Delivered E-micro Palladium Futures Contract

In connection with the listing of New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc.'s ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") physically-delivered E-Micro Palladium Futures contract on trade date Monday, April 29, 2019 (see [SER-8223](#) published April 4, 2019, please note below and in [Exhibit B](#) of NYMEX Submission No. [19-003](#), the corresponding spot-month position limit (Rule 559), aggregation allocation (Rule 559.D.), single month and all month accountability level (Rule 560) and reportable level (Rule 561) for the new contract. The July 2019 contract shall be the first listed contract month. The new contract is physically delivered.
