SUBJECT: Position Limits, Accountability Levels and Large Trader Reporting

Requirements in Connection with the Initial Listing of Two (2) Crude

**Oil Futures Contracts** 

In connection with the listing of New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc.'s ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") two (2) Crude Oil Futures Contracts on trade date Monday, March 9, 2020 (see SER-8537 published February 11, 2020), please note below and in Exhibit B of NYMEX Submission No. 20-054 the corresponding spot-month position limits (Rule 559), aggregation allocations (Rule 559.D.), single month and all month accountability levels (Rule 560) and reportable levels (Rule 561) for the new contracts. The new, financially settled, contracts shall have diminishing balances.
