**SUBJECT:** Delisting of the European Hot Rolled Coil, Ex-Works Ruhr Germany (Platts) Futures and Steel Billet, FOB Black Sea (Platts) Futures Contracts

Earlier today, Monday, March 13, 2017, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") delisted the two (2) metals futures contracts (the "Contracts") as set forth in the table below.

European Hot Rolled Coil, Ex-Works Ruhr Germany (Platts) Futures	NSF	871
Steel Billet, FOB Black Sea (Platts) Futures	SSF	869

The Contracts were listed for trading on CME Globex and for submission for clearing through CME ClearPort. There was no open interest in the Contracts.

As a result of the delisting, information regarding the Contract has been deleted from the respective product rule chapter, related position limits in the Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 (Trading Qualifications and Practices) of the CME Rulebook, the CME Globex non-reviewable ranges located in Rule 588.H. of the NYMEX Rulebook, and the list of block-eligible products located on the CME Group website.
