SUBJECT: Delisting of Four (4) Baltic Dry Freight Futures Contracts

Effective immediately, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") delisted four (4) Baltic Dry Freight futures contracts (the "Contracts") as set forth in the table below.

Capesize 5TC Timecharter Average (Baltic) Futures	769	CF2
Panamax Timecharter Average (Baltic) Futures	945	PFU
Supramax Timecharter Average (Baltic) Futures	946	SFT
Handysize Timecharter Average (Baltic) Futures	943	HFT

The Contracts were listed for trading on CME Globex and for submission for clearing through CME ClearPort. There was no open interest in the Contracts.

As a result of the delisting, information regarding the Contracts were deleted from the respective product rule chapters, related position limits in the Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 (Trading Qualifications and Practices) of the CME Rulebook, the CME Globex non-reviewable ranges located in Rule 588.H. of the NYMEX Rulebook, and the list of block-eligible products located on the CME Group website.
