## Implementation of Pre-Execution Communications and Block Trading in all CME and CBOT Agricultural Futures & Options Contracts

(This SER supersedes S-8026RR dated January 5, 2018, and is being issued to notify the marketplace that effective Tuesday, February 20, 2018, block trading in Soybean Crush Spread Options will not be permitted. No other changes have been made to the original SER.)

Effective Sunday, January 7, 2018 for trade date Monday, January 8, 2018, Chicago Mercantile Exchange Inc. ("CME") and The Board of Trade of the City of Chicago, Inc. ("CBOT") (collectively, the "Exchanges"), will permit block trading in all Agricultural futures, options, outrights, spreads and combinations (the "Contracts") pursuant to the requirements of CME and CBOT Rule 526. ("Block Trades"); add the R-Cross protocol for CME and CBOT futures and CBOT options at all times pursuant to the requirements of CME and CBOT Rule 539.C. ("Pre-Execution Communications Regarding Globex Trades"); and add the G-Cross protocol for all CBOT Agricultural futures pursuant to CBOT Rule 539.C. (collectively, the "Rule Amendments").

The Rule Amendments will enhance customers' abilities to (1) execute large-lot orders, (2) transact in less liquid markets, and (3) trade in products where the Central Limit Order Book ("CLOB") may not be deep enough to execute such orders without disrupting prices.

The Rule Amendments will also change the block trade minimum quantity thresholds and reporting times for the following Agricultural contracts, Australian, Black Sea and EU Wheat, Cash Settled Cheese, Urea, and Crude Palm Oil products, which are currently block eligible. These amendments will harmonize block thresholds and reporting times across the Agricultural complex. Block transactions will be permitted in all CME and CBOT agricultural futures and options contracts.
