SUBJECT: Delisting Three (3) Natural Gas (Platts) Futures Contracts

Earlier today, Monday, April 23, 2018, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") delisted three (3) natural gas contracts (the "Contracts") with no open interest as set out in the table below.

The Contracts were listed for trading on CME Globex as well as for submission for clearing via CME ClearPort. The Exchange previously notified market participants regarding certain NYMEX Natural Gas (Platts) products (see <u>SER 8000</u> dated October 16, 2017). The Exchange is delisting these Contracts as there is no open interest in any listed contract month.

As a result of the delisting, information regarding the Contracts has been deleted from the respective product rule chapter, related position limits in the Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 (Trading Qualifications and Practices) of the CME Rulebook, the CME Globex non-reviewable ranges located in Rule 588.H. of the NYMEX Rulebook, and the list of block-eligible products located on the CME Group website.
