SUBJECT: Delisting of Two (2) Natural Gas (Platts IFERC) Futures Contracts

Effective today, Monday, April 12, 2021, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (“NYMEX” or “Exchange”) delisted two (2) natural gas (Platts IFERC) futures contracts (the “Contracts”) as set forth in the table below. There is no open interest in the Contracts.

The Contracts were listed for trading on CME Globex as well as for submission for clearing via CME ClearPort.

The Exchange previously notified market participants regarding the Contracts (see [SER 8000](#) dated October 16, 2017). At that time, the Exchange advised that December 2021 would be the Contracts’ last listed contract month. Effective immediately, the Exchange delisted the Contracts entirely as there is no open interest in any listed contract month.

Also as a result of the delisting, information regarding the Contracts has been deleted from the respective product rulebook chapters, related position limits in the Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 (“Trading Qualifications and Practices”) of the NYMEX Rulebook, the CME Globex non-reviewable trading ranges located in Rule 588.H. of the NYMEX Rulebook, and the list of block-eligible products located on the CME Group website.
