SUBJECT: Delisting of Eight (8) Energy Futures Contracts

Effective today Monday, July 18, 2022, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") delisted eight (8) energy futures contracts as more specifically set forth in the table below (the "Contracts"). There is no open interest in the Contracts.
