SUBJECT: Delisting of the California Low Carbon Fuel Standard (PRIMA) Futures Contract

Effective today, Monday, October 31, 2022, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (“NYMEX” or “Exchange”) delisted the California Low Carbon Fuel Standard (PRIMA) Futures (the “Contract”) as set forth in the table below. There is no open interest in the Contract.

The Contract was listed for trading on CME Globex as well as for submission for clearing via CME ClearPort.

As a result of the delisting, the product rule chapter and terms and conditions contained in the Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 (Trading Qualifications and Practices) of the NYMEX rulebook (the “Table”), the CME Globex non-reviewable ranges located in Rule 588.H. of the NYMEX rulebook, and the list of block-eligible products located on the CME Group website were removed.
