SUBJECT: Delisting of the NYMEX Platinum/Palladium Spread Futures, COMEX Gold/Silver Ratio Futures, and COMEX Gold/Platinum Spread Futures Contracts

Effective today, Monday, July 31, 2023, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX") and Commodity Exchange, Inc. ("COMEX") (collectively, the "Exchanges") delisted the NYMEX Platinum/Palladium Spread Futures, COMEX Gold/Silver Ratio Futures, and Gold/Platinum Spread Futures contracts as set forth in Table 1. below (the "Contracts") effective immediately. There is no open interest in the Contracts.

The Contracts were listed for trading on CME Globex electronic trading platform ("CME Globex") as well as for submission for clearing via CME ClearPort.

As a result of the delisting, information regarding the Contracts has been deleted from the respective product rulebook chapters, related position limits in the Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 ("Trading Qualifications and Practices") of the NYMEX/COMEX Rulebook, the CME Globex non-reviewable trading ranges located in Rule 588.H., special price fluctuation limits located in Rule 589. of the NYMEX/COMEX Rulebook, and the list of block-eligible products located on the CME Group website.

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
