SUBJECT: Delisting of Eight (8) Electricity Futures Contracts

Effective today, Monday, October 30, 2023, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (“NYMEX” or “Exchange”) delisted eight (8) electricity futures contracts as set forth in table below (the “Contracts”). There is no open interest in the Contracts.

The Contracts are being delisted from the CME Globex electronic trading platform (“CME Globex”) and CME ClearPort, the venues on which they were previously listed.

As a result of the delisting, information regarding the Contracts has been deleted from the respective product rulebook chapters, related position limits in the Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 (“Trading Qualifications and Practices”) of the NYMEX Rulebook, the CME Globex non-reviewable trading ranges located in Rule 588.H., special price fluctuation limits located in Rule 589. of the NYMEX Rulebook, and the list of block-eligible products located on the CME Group website.
