NOTICE

RE: Withdrawal of Corn and Soybean Regularity

The Exchange has granted a request from **Louis Dreyfus Corporation** (“LDC”) to withdraw its regularity for delivery of corn and soybeans at the firm’s **Hennepin, Peru** and **Utica** facilities effective **February 28, 2006**. Currently the firm has 5 soybean shipping certificates outstanding at the Hennepin location. Holders of these certificates have the following options, which are outlined in Regulation 1084.01:

1. Holders of outstanding certificates have thirty days from the date of this notice to take load out of the commodity from LDC.
2. If a holder of outstanding shipping certificate chooses not to take load out during this period, LDC must provide the holder with another shipping certificate at another, mutually acceptable regular shipping station, with adjustments for differences in contract location differentials to apply.
3. If a replacement shipping certificate issued by a regular shipping station at a mutually agreed upon location is unavailable, LDC must provide the holder with an equivalent quantity and quality of the grain designated in the shipping certificate at a mutually acceptable location.
