RE: CHANGES IN CORN/SOYBEAN REGULARITY

The Exchange has received applications from **Cargill, Inc.** for an increase of corn and/or soybean regularity at eight of the firm's facilities, and a request for a soybean regularity decrease at one facility. The following chart shows the applicable facilities, the current daily rate of loading (in bushels), the requested daily rate of loading (in bushels), and the maximum number of shipping certificates that could be issued for each, based on the requested daily rate of loading.

Increases:
