SUBJECT: **Reminder:** New Certification MQM Requirement
DATE: August 20, 2007

To enhance our clearing test environments and to accommodate upcoming merger testing, CME Group is requiring firms to establish new test queues and new channels.

This new-certification environment will mirror production and will manage day-to-day and front-to-back end cert testing, Block-API testing, Front-End-Clearing enhancements, etc.

The current certification region with your already existing queues *will not change* but will be re-named as our "New Release" environment and will be used to test CBOT products.

Firms should install these new queues and channels using the same methodology and port numbers. The new queues will use the following naming convention, where 123 is the clearing member firm number and the ABC is the three letter acronym assigned to each firm MQM channel.
