SUBJECT: **Pit Trade Migration, Friday April 21, 2006**

Effective with business commencing Friday, April 21, 2006 CME will start the migration of pit traded products from the 3270 based Trade Entry System (TES) to the web-based Front-End Clearing system, or "FEC". Products scheduled to be processed in FEC on Friday include all CME agricultural futures and options products, as listed below (commodity code in parentheses):

Live Cattle (48)  
Lean Hogs (LN)  
Pork Bellies (56)  
Feeder Cattle (62)  
Milk (DA)  
Non-Fat Dry Milk (NF)  
Mid - Milk options (JQ)  
Lumber (LB)  
Butter (DB)  
Class IV Milk (DK)  
Cash Butter (CB)  
DAP (DP)  
Urea (UF)  
Uan (UL)  
Ethanol (EH)

Following Thursday night's clearing cycle, all remaining end of day agricultural out-trades (futures and options) will automatically roll to FEC. Firms will not need to re-add out-trades to FEC. As such, these out-trades will not be available in TES on Friday morning. Out-trades can be viewed in We show/ They show screens in FEC. Additionally, Dairy Bundles will need to be entered in the bundle entry screen in FEC (TES will no longer accept Dairy products for bundle entry).
