Subject: CME Group - Carvill Hurricane Index™ and CME Group - Carvill Hurricane Index™ Cat-In-A-Box Futures and Options on Futures Listings and Contract Changes – Effective Sunday, December 30, 2007 and Sunday, February 24, 2008

New Contract Listings and Contract Changes

Effective Sunday, December 30, 2007 (trade date Monday, December 31, 2007), the CME Group - Carvill Hurricane Index and CME Group - Carvill Hurricane Index Cat-In-A-Box Futures and Options on Futures contracts' first three events will be listed for trading. For the CME Group - Carvill Hurricane Index Futures and Options on futures, the HX1, HX2 and HX3 contracts will be listed; for the CME Group – Carvill Hurricane Index Cat-In-A-Box Futures and Options on Futures, the HP1, HP2 and HP3 contracts will be listed for trading. When these contracts are listed for trading, they will represent named storms as detailed in the table below; rather than being associated with a region, as currently defined.

Additionally, on **Sunday, December 30, 2007**, the CME Group - Carvill Seasonal Hurricane Index and CME Group - Carvill Seasonal Maximum Hurricane Index futures and options on futures will be listed for trading. These contracts will continue to represent the five originally designated hurricane regions.

Additional Contract Changes

Effective Sunday, February 24, 2008 (trade date Monday, February 25, 2008), the CME Group - Carvill Hurricane Index and CME Group - Carvill Hurricane Index Cat-In-A-Box Futures and Options on Futures contracts' identities will change from numbered events associated to landfall in a specific region, to identifying them by named storms. The concept of landfall "regions" will be retired. The impact on the life of the contract is that once a named storm is declared a hurricane, the contract would be activated. Contracts will, therefore, potentially have a longer life, as they will remain active until the storms make landfall or dissipate at sea.

Ticker codes are detailed below; these codes, previously used to identify the different hurricane regions, will now denote different potential named storms:
