SUBJECT: REMINDER: Upcoming Position Report Changes

DATE: September 20, 2010

On **September 18, 2010** CME Clearing will be installing the necessary changes for processing the CBT exchange through the new positions system. One result of this will be several report changes which are noted below. Firm FTP report packets will <u>not</u> be impacted with these changes. The reports will first be run on **September 20, 2010**. Another change to the Positions System will be that users will need to select a product exchange to do searches. The "ALL" selection will no longer be available.

On **October 16, 2010** all firm CBT positions will be migrated to the new system. At that time firm reports in the FTP packets will change. The various CPM titled reports in the packets will be replaced with their POS analogues.

Trade Register Reports

The trade register reports will be broken up by exchanges. The existing POS591E, POS591I, POS593E reports will be renamed. The exchange data on the existing Intraday Pay/Collect Summary report (POS591I) will all be contained in one report but will be separated by exchange within the report. The out-trade register report for each exchange will be contained within the relevant POS591 report. There are no report format changes to the reports.

Exercise and Assignment Reports

The existing POS647, POS650 will be changed to reflect the different exchanges. The formats will not change.

In addition, there will be a new report numbered POS645 which will be an option exercise and assignment summary report. Firms will be able to see a summary of their exercises, assignments, money amounts and expirations for each option contract in one report.
