SUBJECT: Product Modification Summary for Clearing Firms, Bookkeeping Software Providers, ISVs

Delisting of Futures Contract Months and Suspension of Listing of Additional Options Contract Months for Tanker Freight Route TD3 (Baltic) on NYMEX

Earlier today, Monday, December 21, 2015, the New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (NYMEX or Exchange) delisted previously-listed contract months for one Futures contract, set out in the table below. No additional further contract months shall be listed for the Freight Route TD3 (Baltic) Futures contract.

In addition, effective on Sunday, January 10, 2016 for trade date Monday, January 11, 2016, and pending all relevant CFTC regulatory review periods, the Exchange will suspend listing new contract months in the Options contract, set out in the table below.

As such the last contract month available for clearing is December 2017 for both contracts.

The futures contract is listed for trading on CME Globex and for submission for clearing through CME ClearPort. The options contract is available for trading on CME Globex and the NYMEX trading floor and for submission for clearing through CME ClearPort. There was no open interest in the de-listed futures contract months.
