SUBJECT: Delisting of Previously-Listed Contract Months for the Freight Route TD3

(Baltic) Futures Contract and Suspension of Listing of Additional Contract Months for the Freight Route TD3 (Baltic) Average Price Options Contract

Earlier today, Monday, December 21, 2015, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") delisted previously-listed contract months for the Freight Route TD3 (Baltic) Futures contract (Clearing Code: TL; CME Globex Code: TL; NYMEX Rule Chapter: 684). As such the last contract month available for trading and clearing is December 2017. There was no open interest in the subject contract months that were delisted.

In addition, effective on Sunday, January 10, 2016 for trade date Monday, January 11, 2016, and pending all relevant CFTC regulatory review periods, the Exchange will suspend listing new contract months in the Freight Route TD3 (Baltic) Average Price Options Contract (Clearing Code: TDT; CME Globex Code: TDT; NYMEX Rule Chapter: 949). This contract is listed on a two year annual roll, and is currently listed to December 2017 contract.
