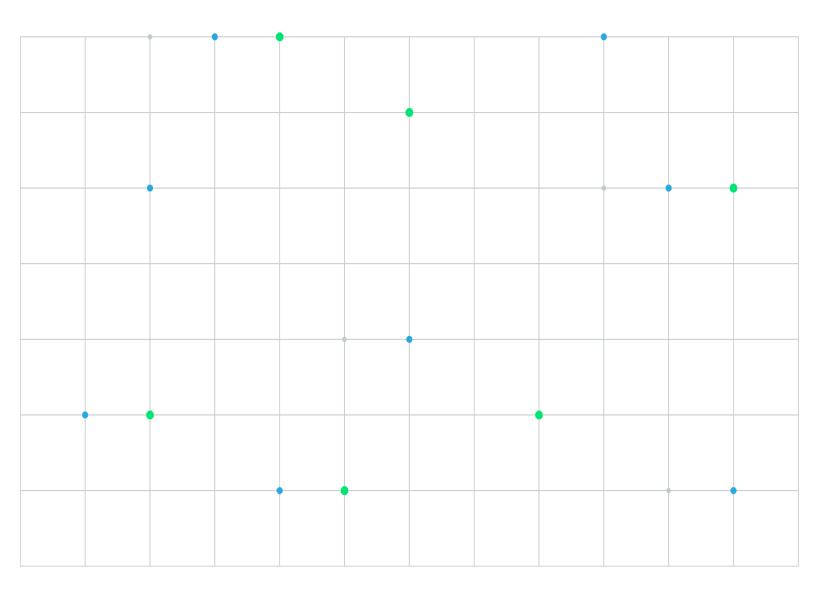


AutoCert+ BrokerTec Cancel and Cancel/Replace by Client Order ID User Manual

Neither futures trading nor swaps trading are suitable for all investors, and each involves the risk of loss. Getting Started

The AutoCert+ tool is an automated testing tool for validating application functionality. It provides a web interface for using CME Group certification scenarios.

To facilitate the process of connecting a customer application to CME Globex, CME Group provides a dedicated certification environment to allow customers to test their systems before completing certification.

The following apply to each iLink order entry test case:

- The book is clear at the beginning of each test.
- After the instrument is selected, it is locked until the test is completed.
- If you submit an incorrect response to any question in a test case, you must repeat the test case from the beginning.
- For partial or complete fills, assume CME Group creates the appropriate orders in the book.

Note: If a test is not proceeding to the next step, selecting the Refresh button (REFRESH) below the test steps may resolve the issue.

The following procedures describe and illustrate the process for customers that have certified to BrokerTec order entry to access the supplemental certification test suite to support CME Globex Cancel By ClOrdID functionality by performing additional certification.



To access and navigate AutoCert+:


- 1. Log into the automated certification tool.
- 2. Review general AutoCert+ test suite navigation and general interview information.

Access the Cancel and Cancel / Replace by Client Order ID test suite.

Use the AutoCert+ testing configuration menu to select the following:

- Tester: Automatically selected based on the logged in user
- Company Name
- Market: BrokerTec EU/US
- Purpose: Order Entry
- Application System: Select the system to test
- Test Suite: Cancel and Cancel/Replace by ClOrdID
- Sendercomp Sendercomp: Select Sendercomp

- 3. Complete the Interview for this test suite.
- 4. Complete applicable test cases.
- 5. Complete the certification process from the Post Certification tab.

Then proceed to the Test Suite.



Order Cancel Replace without OrderID

The purpose of this test is to verify the client system can submit and modify a Day limit order without providing an OrderID (tag 37).

This test case is mandatory if the response to the <u>interview</u> question "Will your system support Cancel Replace without OrderID?" is **Yes**.

- 1. Select a SenderComp from the drop-down and select ASSIGN if an Instrument is not already assigned.
- 2. From the Instrument(s) drop-down, select the desired instrument if it is not already locked.
- 3. Select the **START TEST** button.

Note: DO NOT select the START TEST button once the test is in progress. If a test is not proceeding to the next step, selecting the Refresh button (REFRESH) below the test steps may resolve the issue.


Pre-Registered or On-Demand Format

This test is used for both Pre-Registered and On-Demand formats. The below instructions show the Pre-Registered format.




- 1. Over an iLink connection submit a <u>Day Limit Order</u> Message [tag 35=D | tag 59-TimeInForce=0 (Day) | tag 40-Order-Type=2 (Limit order)].
- 2. Receive and Process the Execution Report New Order Message (35=8, 39=0).
- 3. Submit and Order Cancel / Replace Request without OrderID Message (35-MsgType=G | tag 11-ClOrdID | without tag 37-OrderID).
- 4. Receive and process an Execution Report Modify Message (35=8, 39=5).

Order Cancel without OrderID

- 3. Select the START TEST button.


Pre-Registered or On-Demand Format

- 1. Over an iLink connection submit a New Day Limit Order Message [35=D | tag 59-TimeInForce=0 (Day) | tag 40-Order-Type=2 (Limit order)].
- 2. Receive and Process the Execution Report New Order Message (35=8, 39=0).
- 3. Submit and Order Cancel Request without OrderID Message (35=F | tag 11-ClOrdID | without tag 37-OrderID).
- 4. Receive and process an Execution Report Cancel Message (35=8, 39=4).
